SONOMA INTERNATIONAL FILM FESTIVAL (SIFF) ANNOUNCES FILM WINNERS FOR #SIFF2021 27,000+ Streams | 6,300+ Hours of Media Consumed

Sonoma, CA--The Sonoma International Film Festival concluded its online film festival yesterday screening a slate of more

than 120 films from 40 countries, with 20 films making their premieres, as well as hosting three live Drive-Ins. Global reach included viewers from Japan, Germany, Switzerland, India, Canada, France, Brazil, United Kingdom, Spain, Mexico and Sweden, as well as throughout the United States. The Jury Awards include films from around the world with director Óscar Bernàcera, a winner in two categories, and Caroline Link, prior Oscar winner for Best Foreign Film Nowhere In Africa in 2001.

"In our second year hosting a virtual festival, we continue to expand our audience around the globe," said SIFF Artistic Director Kevin W. McNeely. "Our three live drive-ins allowed us to gather together safely on a beautiful Sonoma night under a full moon and enjoy the communal power of film; and we are particularly proud of our community which collectively provided our local First Responders and Frontline healthcare workers with more than 125 donated passes."

Susan Atherton, longtime SIFF sponsor, also underwrote the film Escape From Extinction with ticket sales and viewer donation proceeds, totaling over \$6,000, to be given to the Conservation Society of California | Oakland Zoo.

SIFF Saturdays, the online screening series on the last Saturday of each month, continues April 24 with the French film Roxane presented by Safe Harbor Wine Storage. The taped SIFF | Safe Harbor Wine Storage Wine Awards, presented by San Francisco Magazine, will precede the film.
