Yan becomes the second chef to be honored by SIFF. Chef Jacques Pépin was the inaugural recipient in 2022.

"We're excited Chef Yan is joining us for our Chef and Shorts event, and he'll actually be cooking, which doubles the excitement," said SIFF Artistic Director Carl Spence. "It's wonderful to honor this world-class chef along with world-class cinema, so it's a great pairing."

Yan is the recipient of the 2022 James Beard Foundation Lifetime Achievement Award. He has hosted more than 3,500 cooking shows around the world and is an accomplished chef, a restauranteur, a respected culinary educator, a commentator, and a food and hospitality consultant. His award-winning PBS series "Yan Can Cook", airing since 1978, has introduced generations of North American audiences to Chinese and Asian cuisines. He has authored more than 30 culinary books and has made guest appearances on "Iron Chef," "Top Chef," "Master Chef," "Hell's Kitchen," and "Check, Please!", among others.

Yan will prepare a course during the event which will also showcase other esteemed chefs, top wines, and a curated selection of culinary cinema to be named in the coming weeks. The dinner is a collaboration with Devour! The Food Film Festival and Chef Michael Howell and Co-Director Lia Rinaldo.


